The Indian freedom movement directed from the Sevagram. Gandhiji had initiated his personal 'satyagraha' of 1940 from Ashram. Vinoba Bhave was the first Indian 'Satyagrahi' of this movement. All British rules have been intensifying opposed by the 'Bharat Chhodo' (Leave India Movement) which was originated in Sevagram Ashram only. Late evening departure to Bettiah/Motihari.</p>

				Bettiah/ Motihari	<p>Today after breakfast visit Motihari, Motihari soil holds the starting point of Indian's independence movement launched by Gandhi Ji. Gandhi Museum and a Stone Pillar are there to commemorate Mahatma Gandhi's links with Motihari. Gandhiji's courageous statement given before a magistrate is inscribed here on a stone.</p> <p>Night Stay in Dharamshala/ Dormitory accommodation.</p>

Day 7 23.06.17 04:00 2330 Varanasi

Arrival at Varanasi, visit Sarnath and Vishwanath temple Overnight stay in Dharamshala/ Dormitory accommodation. Mahatma Gandhi Kashi Vidyapith - The boycott of government-aided educational institutions during the Non-Cooperation Movement coupled with Mahatma Gandhi's programme of National Education exerted a great deal of influence on Prasad Gupta. As a consequence, the Vidyapith came into being. Students joining Mahatma Gandhi's boycott call took admission in the Vidyapith. Shiv Prasad Gupta established the Har Prasad Smarak Nidhi in memory of his deceased brother, for the operation of the Vidyapith, which subsequently proved to be a fertile nursery for national freedom movement activities.



Day 8 24.06.17 0430 17:00 Allahabad

Arrival at Allahabad. Visit Sangam and Anand Bhavan.

Allahabad became the administrative head in this region. Meanwhile, in between 1888 to 1892, the grounds of Darbhanga Castle became an important meeting point for the Indian National Congress. At this point, the city gave birth to several revolutionaries. It was in the year 1920 when Mahatma Gandhi first launched the Quit India Movement from Allahabad. In 1931, the leaders of the Indian Congress frequently met at Anand Bhavan, the family home of Nehru. Many of India's prominent leaders like Jawaharlal Nehru, Mangla Prasad, Muzaffar Hasan, K. N. Katju, and Lal Bahadur Shastri hailed from this city. **Departure to Surat in evening.** (Via - MKP,KTE,JBP,ET,JL)
